- 4) As you spend time daily this week in prayer, consider using the A.C.T.S. method. You can do this by implementing **A**doration, **C**onfession, **T**hanksgiving and **S**upplication into your prayer life.

Which part of the ACTS method do you think is the easiest to do? Which is the most difficult?

- 5) Consider how Peter's circumstances changed between Acts 12:1-4 and Acts 12:24. Then consider how Herod's circumstances changed in that same span of time. What contrast do you see between the two?

- 6) What role do you think prayer made in the word of God increasing and multiplying in verse 24?
