

3rd Grade WHAT TO BRING

*Label everything! This will help us sort out items lying around at the end of the week.

- Bible, notepad, and pen
- Toiletries—shampoo, toothpaste, toothbrush, soap, deodorant etc.
- Bedding—blankets, sheets, pillow or sleeping bag and pillow
- Towels and washcloths
- Water bottle that you can refill and carry with you
- Closed toe, closed heel shoes (for outdoor activities) - tennis shoes are very necessary!
- Sun protection
- Spending money for camp store and missions offering. We will not be visiting the snack store.
- We suggest you pack 4 sets of clothing, keeping in mind that camp always has water balloon, shaving cream and other messy type activities. Also pack some nice clothing for evening worship. Read Centri-kid Dress Code Carefully! (see below)
- Centri-kid has asked that each child bring a YELLOW t-shirt** to be ruined during the Organized Mass Chaos game.
- Shower caddy & Shower shoes – we all share one bathroom.
- Dirty clothing bag and a bag for wet clothing (OMC on Thursday is very messy!)
- Appropriate swimwear ...wear modest, one-piece bathing suits or two-piece suits covered with a colored t-shirt. Note dark colored t-shirt required for H2O track.
- Drinks, if desired – 6-pack of water, juice or Gatorade. NO snacks please.
- Watch (optional) – very helpful to get students to meeting spots on time.

LHBC Children's Ministry will provide:

- A light bag to carry Bible, notebook, pen and water bottle around camp. This will help us quickly identify our kids in the crowd.
- Snacks for each evening and the bus ride home.
- A variety of over the counter meds to be administered if OTC approval form is submitted.

DO NOT BRING - alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs, fireworks, water guns, or any kind of weapon

DO NOT BRING - radios, iPods, CD players, roller blades, skateboards or cell phone

DRESS CODE

Please ask your students and adult sponsors NOT to pack anything that: ♦ **Has spaghetti straps**, except for sleepwear (regular sleeveless shirts are fine) ♦ **Is excessively short or tight fitting**. ♦ Advertises alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs ♦ Explicitly or implicitly promotes racism, sexism, or hatred of any group or person ♦ Explicitly or implicitly refers to sexual actions or situations

While at camp, we ask that students and adults: ♦ Wear modest, one-piece bathing suits or two-piece suits covered with a colored t-shirt. ♦ Wear modest shorts, dresses, slacks, and jeans for worship. Long pants or knee-length skirts are required for students or adults participating in worship on stage. ♦ Do not dress in a way that calls attention to underwear (sagging your pants, rolling down your waistbands) ♦ A dark t-shirt if you plan to participate in any water tracks.
