

Centri-kid 4/5 Campers and Parents,

I am really excited about camp this year. We have a balanced number of girls and boys going, some great counselors and an awesome theme to look forward to. But first we must hammer out some details. Please read through this letter carefully as some things have changed from last year.

The Camp Parent Meeting will be on May 23 at 4:00pm in room 314-315. The 4/5th grade parents will start by getting your forms notarized, your insurance cards copied and paperwork turned in. At 4:30 we will move into room 317 for some additional info from Cindy and an opportunity to meet counselors and ask questions. It is extremely important that one parent attends this meeting; students are not required to attend.

Camper Packet: To save on postage we have placed all camp permission forms (to be notarized), “What to Bring” notes and additional resources on the website at www.livinghopewired.com/childrenscamp. Please download them there or pick up a copy in the Children’s Ministry office. There is lots of info to go through before the parent meeting on May 23.

Additional Notes:

- Note your final balance below and verify that it matches with your records. Please turn in asap or contact me about a scholarship request.
- The dorm rooms are all in one hall for each gender. The students sleep 2 or 3 to a room. The chaperones from Living Hope will be scattered throughout the hall. All rooms share a bathroom.
- Roommate request – if your child would like to room with someone specific, please let me know in writing before or during the Parent Meeting on May 23. We must hear from both parents before we will place the students in the same room. Room assignments will be finalized 2 weeks before camp. (note: if you marked a roommate down on your online registration you do not need to let me know again.)
- Very important! Students will not have time to email or call you during the week. Please do not send cell phones, ipods, gameboys or CD players (Cindy will collect them), ... **they are not allowed at camp per Centri-kid.**

- Medications – Download a Medication Information Form online. Place medication (in original bottles only) in individual Ziploc bags labeled with medication name and turn in with form on Monday, July 12. Label everything! In order for us to give over the counter meds please sign and return the OTC Approval Form (online).
- Snacks – we ask that you NOT send any snacks with your child with the exception of a 6-pack of juice/Gatorade or water; please no soda. The children’s ministry will provide snacks for the week and the ride home.
- Tracks – students will participate in two tracks during camp. There is a list of ideas online. When we arrive at camp students will be able to pick several they are interested in.
- Camp DVD or Group Picture: Each year Centri-kid takes a group photo (\$6) and sells a camp DVD (\$30). If you are interested in purchasing one or both of these for your child, print the online order form and submit with payment to me.
- You can send mail to the camp if you would like. It might be a good idea to send it a couple days before camp to ensure your student gets it. Address mail to:
